

Woodfin Sanitary Water and Sewer District
Watershed Visitation Instructions and Liability Release Form

The Woodfin Sanitary Water and Sewer District allows visitation to its watershed for certain educational and scientific purposes; general pleasure hiking and other leisure activities are not permitted. In order to ensure the safety of our customers and of those visiting the watershed for permitted uses, the following rules and regulations must be observed:

1. ***Pack it in, pack it out*** – All materials brought into the watershed, such as food, drink, equipment, and the like must be removed when exiting the watershed.
2. ***Take only memories, leave only footprints*** – Unless otherwise permitted by the District, do not remove items from the watershed nor damage objects within the watershed.
3. ***Reach out and touch someone*** – We must know your general location, your approximate departure time, the names and number of individuals in your party, and the type of vehicle(s) you are driving. **All visitors must register by telephone at the District's water treatment plant prior to arrival; telephone number is (828) 658-1714.**
4. ***Enter at your own risk*** – The District cannot assume any liability for illness, injury, or any other misfortune you or anyone within your party may suffer while visiting the watershed.

Please remember during your visit to the watershed that it is a remote wilderness area preserved primarily for the production of drinking water for the District's customers. As such, trails may be poorly marked or not marked at all, wildlife may be encountered, and communication with the outside world via cell phone will be difficult, if not impossible. **The District reserves the right to refuse entry or require exit to any persons for any reason, without exception. Prior permission to access the watershed is not a guarantee for future access. Automobiles parked at the treatment plant beyond operational hours may be locked inside the gate until next opening hour or towed if suitable arrangements or contact has not been made with treatment plant personnel.**

Liability Release Statement
